On 13th January 2009, this wing was inaugurated by Jagdish Tytler, Member of Parliament and Kripashankar Singh, MLA & President- Mumbai Pradesh advanced Ophthalmic Care Center has aesthetically designed two operation theatres, patient waiting lounge, CC TV, post operative recovery rooms with state of the art equipments. The hospital offers services for Phacoemulsification, Glaucoma Surgery, Corneal Grafting, Squint Surgery, Eye Sonography, Wavefront Guided Lasik Laser (Customized), Refraction, Contact Lenses, Retinal & Vitreous Surgery as well as Lasik.

Kenia Eye Hospital plans to start Phaco Charitable Training Center to train technicians & nurses to serve masses. By 2013, Kenia Eye Hospital will start Mobile Eye Charitable Centers in all four corners of Mumbai to provide eye care services at the doorstep of the patients. The experts will carry out all the tests related to eye and have consultation on internet with Dr. Vaishal Kenia, if necessary. So, the patients need not travel in traffic congestion of Mumbai to the hospital just for check up. Hence, only those patients requiring surgery need travel to hospital at Santacruz (W). In addition, plans are also afoot to start an eye research institute.

Under "FULL STOP" Eye Surgery, a state of the art 1.8mm Micro-incision Cataract Surgery (MICS) is now performed in the hospital. Only two very small incisions of 1.8mm or less

are required to perform the entire cataract surgery. This surgery is carried out with newly introduced "Phaco" Machine, whereby an ultrasound probe is used to safely break up the cataract by a technique called "Micro Phacoemulsification". The cataract is then removed by suction and then Micro foldable Intraocular lens (IOL) is inserted instead of usual foldable lens. This surgery is called "Full Stop" Eye Surgery or Pin Hole Cataract Surgery as the two very small incisions made in the eyes are small punctures, due to which, the wounds are self sealing. In this way, nothing from outside can enter the eyes.

This surgery is safe, reliable, less invasive & gentler surgery for improved comfort of the patient.

The hospital has commenced a new Retinal Division with FFA Angiography & Ocular CT Scan (OCT) facilities, with latest "Optovue" state of the art machine. This is a big boon for patients having Diabetes related retinal problems as they can be detected at early stages with the help of advanced diagnostics retinal tools, like FFA & OCT.

It can also help in early detection of Macular Degeneration (age related retinal problems), which can result in blindness, if not detected in time.
